- Communicate partnership info to AIC members
- Evaluate the characteristics of various types of partnerships
- Identify impediments to successful partnerships
- Provide innovative partnership recommendations
 - Enhance WR-ALC depot and supply chain functions
 - Improve community's capability to accept new RAFB missions
 - Stimulate capital investment and jobs in Middle Georgia

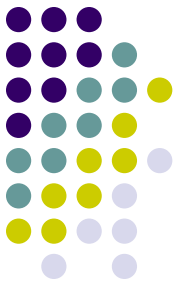
Financial

Financial Sub-committee Report--2006

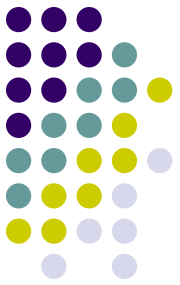


- AIC should be first in line for consideration
