- Description: Affords aircrew, weapons and airframe protection. Provides for passenger self evacuation and rescue. Built to NFPA 414 standards

- Description: Larger version of the P-19. Protects larger cargo planes and in addition to passenger evacuation, this truck provides high reach capability

Challenges/Opportunities



- Programming Process
 - MAJCOMS provide requirements projections 5 years out
 - Based on tomorrow's needs
 - Dollars projected based on standard costs
- Procurement Process
 - Changes in year of execution based on today's needs
 - Actual dollars usually less than projections
- Contracting Process
 - Contracting process in multiple agencies
 - Different rules of engagement
