 - ◆ 7000 people, 3-shifts, single campus
 - ◆ AMXG: C-5, C-17, C-130 & F-15
 - ◆ EMXG: Avionics
 - ◆ CMXG: Fabrication and Industrial Backshop
 - ◆ MXSG: Infrastructure Support
 - ◆ SMXG: Software
 - ◆ Staff: Human Resources, Quality/Safety, Business Development, Financial Management, Training
 - **Period of Performance**
 - 10 year period of performance (1 year basic with nine (9) annual options)
 - One week audit period
