- Description: Enclosed capsules and open pallet platform used on US Government aircraft (C-17, KC-10 and C-130J): Senior Leader In-Transit Conference Capsule (SLICC) and Senior Leader In-Transit Pallet (SLIP), provides Distinguished Visitor (DV) a dedicated space suitable for performing work and obtaining rest while airborne

# Combat Sustainment Wing Advanced Power Technology Office (APTO)

---



- Provides A&AS mission support to the Advanced Power Technology Office (APTO), USAF, Robins AFB, GA Program Management, Engineering, Logistics, Financial Analysis, and Administrative Support.
- Projects include:
  - Smart Micro-grid Power Management
  - Hydrogen Refueling Stations and Fuel Cell Vehicles at Hickam/Robins AFBs – Renewable power sources (wind and solar)
  - Solar Arrays at Toledo (500kw) and Camp Perry(140kw) ANG Bases in Ohio
  - Lithium-ion Battery Vehicles-McGuire/ Dyess AFBs
  - Heavy Duty Hybrid Electric Vehicles – Various AFBs
  - Waste-to-Energy Technology

- Develop Acq Plan for Group A&AS contract Mar 12 – Mar 13
  - Award contract Mar 13
  - Task Orders delivered as existing A&AS contracts expire As Required
