Service Description

Warner Robins Air Logistics Center

- Legacy Applications Branch provides professional, technical, and analytical business process support and directs Legacy Software Application maintenance support for the Center
- Legacy applications with a current need for contractor support include the Depot Maintenance Accounting and Production System (DMAPS), Facility and Equipment Maintenance (FEMS), PDMSS and Enterprise Management Information System (EMIS)
- Government requires additional WR-ALC business process expertise, software application expertise, and Oracle & SQL database design expertise to support expected workload
- Information Technology service tasks
 - Develop and/or execute sound requirements management, project management & configuration management practices/procedures
 - Develop application and/or database solutions
 - Review work products for technical accuracy and adequacy
 - Investigate software and db deficiencies for legacy application systems
 - Support application functional and load testing



Current Status of Service



Warner Robins Air Logistics Center

- Non-organic support currently supplied via three separate contracts
- Legacy applications covered by this proposed contract are expected to continue through at least 2013

 - Individuals
- High visibility workload and activity
