COTS Item Description

- Commercial Off The Shelf (COTS) items
 - Circuit cards
 - Digital linear tape (dlt) drives
 - Read-write assy
 - Display units
 - Network analyzers
- End item applications
 - Pave PAWS Radar
 - BMEWS Radar Set Site
 - F-16 Support Equipment
- Items are coded as non-procurable
 - These items are still actively used in the Air Force and we expect this to be the case for the next 10 to 20 years



Current Status of Repair

- Limited number of sources for repair
- Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) not available
- Government is not on possession of data
- Multiple applications and end items



Future Repair/Sustainment Strategy



- Obtain a Strategic Repair Contract with 5 year coverage
 - FY10 Funding
 - Contract value \$500K
 - Approximately 32 NSNs

- Small Business Competitive Contract
 - Firm, Fixed Price

- Sources must have necessary personnel, facilities, equipment



Challenges/Opportunities



- Requirements subject to fluctuation
- Improved customer support
- Establishment of a mutually beneficial relationship
- Long term financial opportunity
